The Town of Shallotte

Shallotte's is the 211th largest community in North Carolina.

Strategically located in the center of southern Brunswick County, Shallotte is considered a key business hub for the area.

Shallotte is the spot where residents and visitors from miles around come to shop, dine and enjoy entertainment.

Shallotte is about 10 minutes from Holden Beach, Ocean Isle Beach and Sunset Beach. Within

the town's 28 square-miles there are more than 610 businesses.

While Shallotte is still considered a small town, it has a lot of amenities often found in larger cities.

- Population 4,304 - Population change since 2000: +172.7%.
- Population Density: 700 people per square mile (low).
- The combined sales tax rate for Shallotte, NC is 6.75%. This is the total of state, county and city sales tax rates. The North Carolina state sales tax rate is currently 4.75%. The Brunswick County sales tax rate is 2%.
- The town of Shallotte has a property tax rate of .35 per \$100 valuation.
- Brunswick County's property tax rate is .485 per \$100 valuation.
- As of March 2016 cost of living index: 94.2 (less than average, U.S. is 100).
- Full time law enforcement 14, officers/1,000 residents: 3.39 - NC Average 2.39.
- 37 miles from Wilmington International Airport & 45 miles from Myrtle Beach International Airport.

- Average temperature December - February - mid 40's. May - September, average temperature ranges from the high 70's to the low 80's. Precipitation reaches its peak in August, with an average rainfall of 7 inches. Tornado activity is near to the state average, and 3% less than the nation's average.
